## Being on a course session

Course sessions last from one to three weeks, where students and lecturers spend intense days of work and study together. The daily programme begins after breakfast, when students meet for a half-hour session in small groups to reflect on the theme of the upcoming two-hour lecture.

The lecture itself is focused on various themes in educational theory and research methods, held by lecturers from Norway and abroad.

The morning lecture is followed by a session of artistic activities, usually music or movement. This in turn, is followed by individual or group exercises related to the theme of the module. These exercises allow the student to work through the presented ideas and concepts, digesting new thoughts, and putting them into context.
